**THE PUSHOUTS** explores the remarkable story of Victor Rios' evolution from school pushout and gang member to UC professor, author, and thought leader on the school-to-prison pipeline. It tells the story of the one-in-three Latino and Black students nationally who do not graduate, are pushed into continuation schools, low-paying jobs, and - too often - the criminal justice and mass incarceration systems. A moderated discussion will take place to explore the systems that impact Black and Brown males which often fail them. How do we welcome and support our formerly incarcerated students as they continue their education at GCC?
