

Transfer Admission Guarantee

Glendale Community College and Pepperdine Seaver College

This Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) Agreement establishes a partnership between **Pepperdine University's Seaver College** and **Glendale Community College (GCC)** to facilitate the transfer of qualified GCC students to Pepperdine with guaranteed admission to select undergraduate programs.

Nationally recognized for its high academic standards and commitment to student success, Pepperdine is a Christian university where students grow in knowledge and character. Located on a scenic campus in Malibu, Seaver College is the university's liberal arts institution, providing rich opportunities for intellectual and spiritual exploration within a diverse community.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Students must submit a completed application for admission, all required supporting materials, and the application fee to Pepperdine University on or before the transfer application deadline.
- Students must have completed at least 30 units at one or more community colleges by the appropriate application deadline.
- Students must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25. This is a cumulative GPA for all courses from all institutions attended. Please note that we will take the average of grades received in repeated courses.
- Admission guarantee is subject to change if a student has incorrect self-reported information, any disciplinary action, excessive withdrawals, or other concerns related to academic ability at Seaver. This will be determined at time of transcript evaluation.

Guaranteed Admission:

- Students who meet the eligibility requirements listed above and submit all required application materials by the application deadline will be guaranteed admission to eligible Seaver College Programs.
- Admission guarantees do not extend to our Fine Arts (Music, Theatre Arts, Theatre and Screen Arts) or Nursing majors.
- Admission guarantees do not guarantee that you will graduate within a certain time frame. We encourage you to refer to [Assist.org](https://www.pepperdine.edu/assistsite) to verify what courses will transfer.
- If a student has an ADT in a comparable subject, they can only complete the following majors within two years: Art History, Communication Studies, Economics, English, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, and Spanish.

Student Responsibilities:

- Students still need to fill out the [Pepperdine Transfer Application](#) by the application deadline of **January 15th for the Fall semester. The Spring semester has a priority deadline of October 1st and final deadline of November 1st.**
- Once the application is complete, you can fill out the TAG Form in your Pepperdine Application Portal.

- All required materials including official college transcripts, proof of high school completion (final high school transcript, GED, or CHSPE), and an academic letter of recommendation must be submitted by the application deadline.
